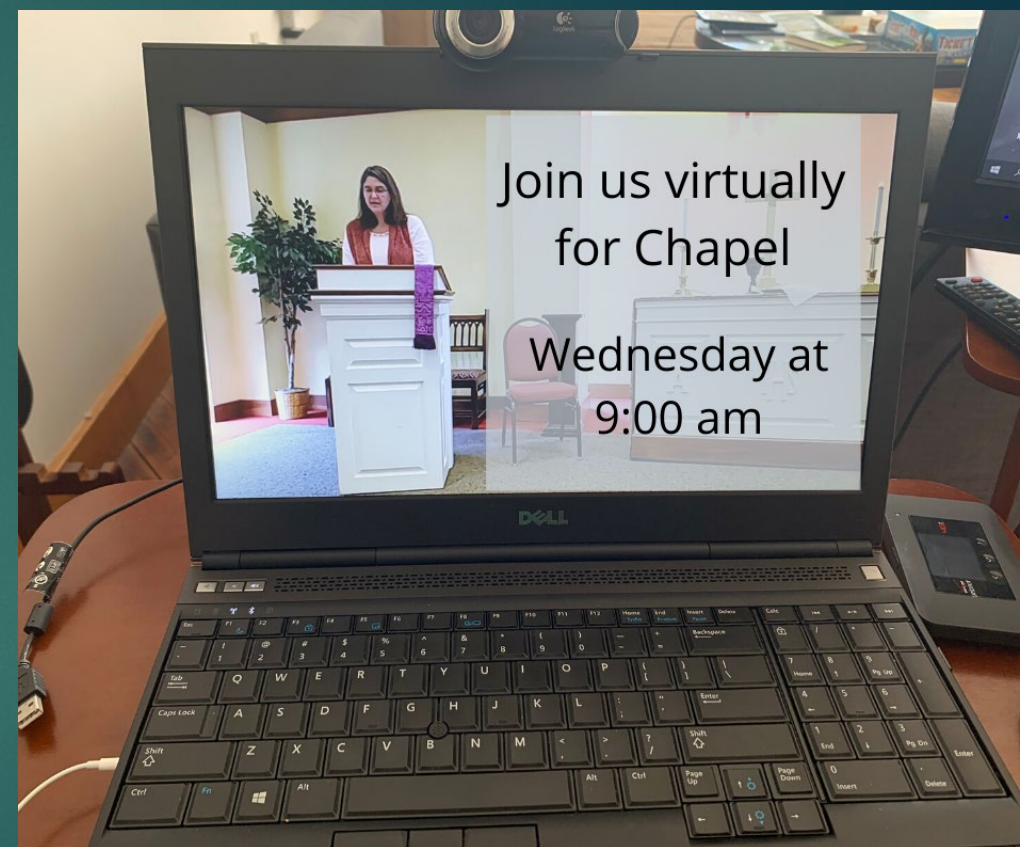

Streaming to the Internet

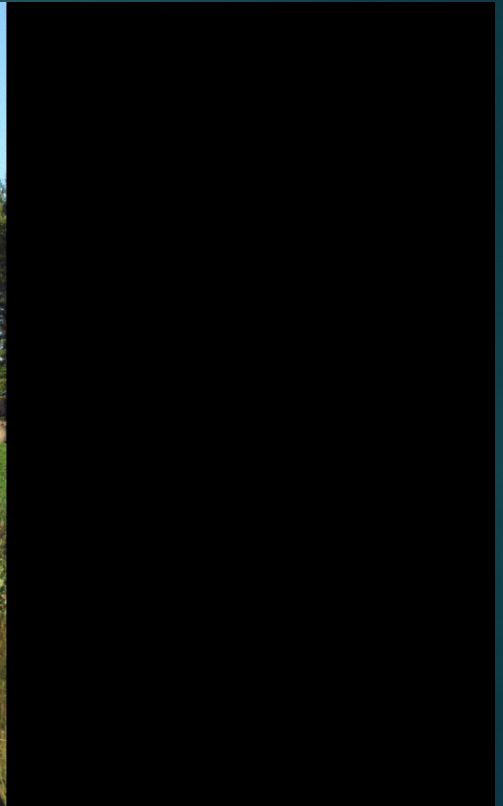
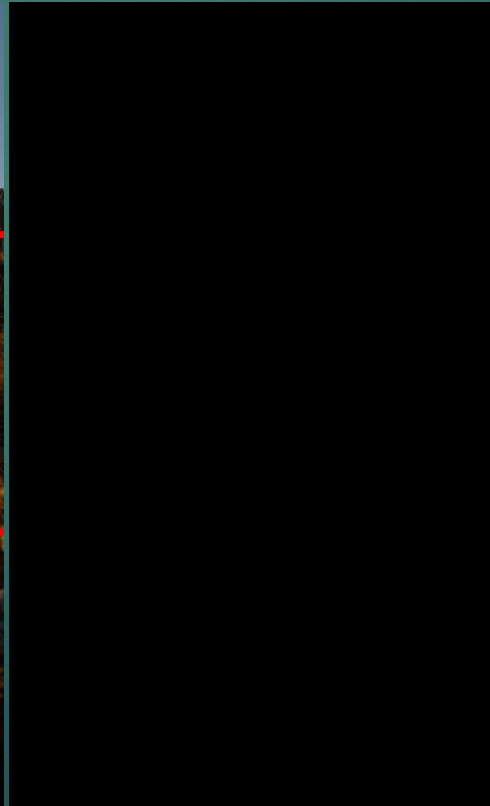
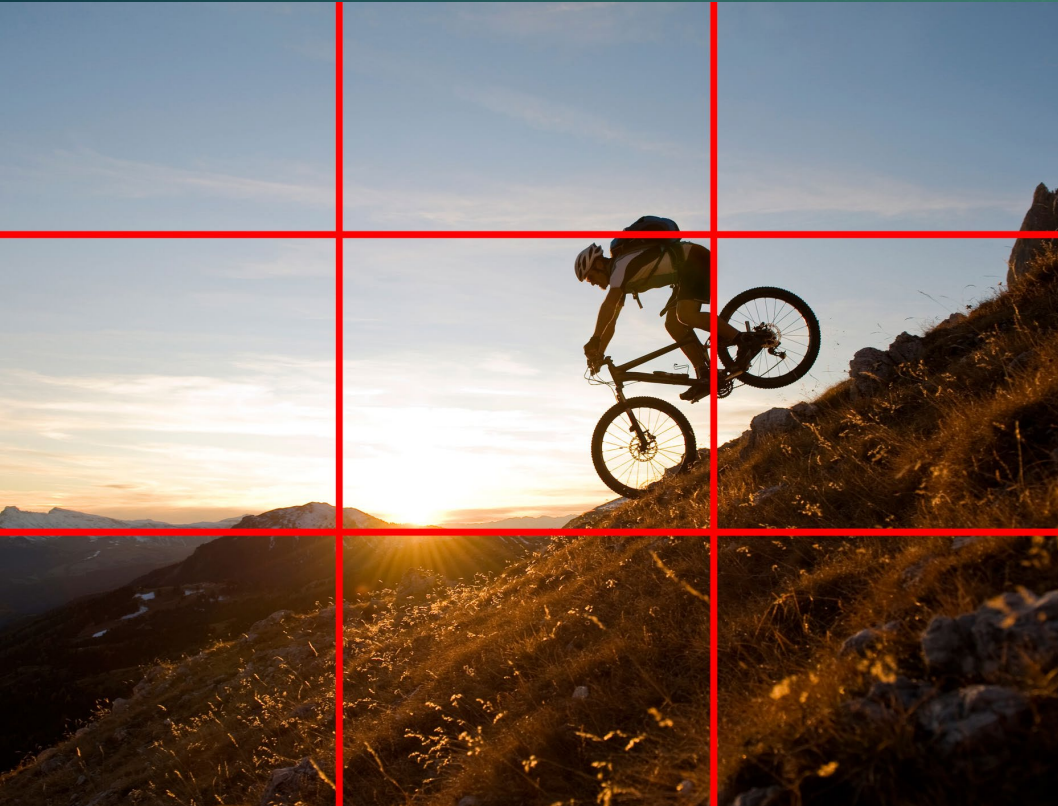
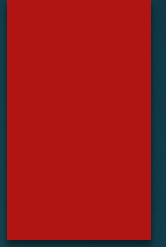
- ▶ Simple is ALWAYS better
 - ▶ Start small and add on
- ▶ How?
 - ▶ Using your phone, you can stream directly to your church Facebook page
 - ▶ Make sure you are filming in landscape, not portrait.
 - ▶ Make sure you have reliable internet or cellular service.
- ▶ When?
 - ▶ Normal worship time
 - ▶ Evening or morning devotional
- ▶ Where?
 - ▶ Facebook, YouTube, Vimeo, Zoom

Audio

- ▶ Mics
 - ▶ Handheld
 - ▶ Lavalier
 - ▶ Shotgun/Boom
- ▶ Things to think about
 - ▶ Is there background noise?
 - ▶ Are you in a space with an echo?
 - ▶ If you are outside, is it windy?
 - ▶ Do you need a TRRS adapter?
- ▶ Music
 - ▶ Make sure you are fully licensed to play music.
