The Rev. Mark Miller of Virginia Beach UMC once taught the men attending Annual Conference that it's easier to avoid temptation than to resist it. If we don't keep God front and center, it is easy to see how evil thoughts can fill the

God-shaped hole in our hearts and lead us to sinful deeds. All we have to do is look at the daily news (or the Bible) to see how the mighty fall. So how do we avoid temptation since it's so hard to resist? Paul, in his letter to the Philippians, tells us to keep our *minds* on Godly things:

"Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things and the God of peace will be with you." Philippians 4:8

For me, keeping my eyes on Jesus while my thoughts are on whatever is noble (and thereby avoiding temptation) requires daily prayer and Bible meditation, a weekly accountability group, weekly worship, and serving others. All of which are God's gracious gifts leading us <u>not</u> into temptation!
