Farmville: Boydton Charge (Boydton, Easters & Rehoboth): Separate Rehoboth from the Boydton Charge to form the new Boydton Charge (Boydton & Easters), Full-Time. Rehoboth becomes part of the Rehoboth-Union Chapel Cooperative Parish (14.g.).

Lynchburg: Leesville and Huddleston/Mount Horeb combine to form the new 3-point charge: Twin Lakes. Also, the Appomattox Charge was previously realigned effective July 1, 2008. Bethel (#475302) was separated and became a part-time appointment. Mount Comfort (#476157) and Trinity (#476168) remained as the Appomattox Charge and continued full-time.

Winchester: Discontinue the Cokesbury Charge (Happy Creek and Howellsville). Happy Creek is discontinued (14.c.3.) and Howellsville becomes Part-Time. Marshall and Middleburg become Marshall-Middleburg Charge.
