This year we have been informed that to deliver the amount of kits we normally collect to Mission Central in Pennsylvania, they would be overwhelmed. Additionally, since we will not be meeting in one central location this year, we felt that it would be good for this year to offer a mission opportunity for all churches in the Virginia Conference to show our strength in numbers, by uniting as one, and also to engage in something we are somewhat familiar with, while adding a twist.

This year we are inviting each church to host a canned food drive (collection), as well as participate in creating hygiene kits and school kits. The cans and the kits will be dropped off at a designated site or sites on each district. The drop off times will be between 2:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., on June 19, 2021. All of the cans and kits collected will stay locally and help support local ministry partners in your area.
