- 2. All members, lay and clergy, will receive an email with a link to join the "Bar of the Conference." The Friday session, when voting will occur, will be from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- 3. Our guests without vote will be able to view the proceedings as a live stream.
- 4. The digital version of the *Book of Reports* will be available on the conference website mid-May. For members who did not opt-out of a print version, paper copies will also be mailed in May.
- 5. Significant opportunities will be available to "Test your Tech" and learn how to electronically navigate participation and voting at the virtual Annual Conference.
