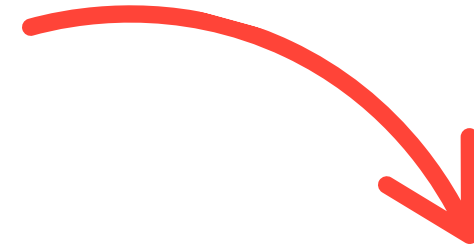

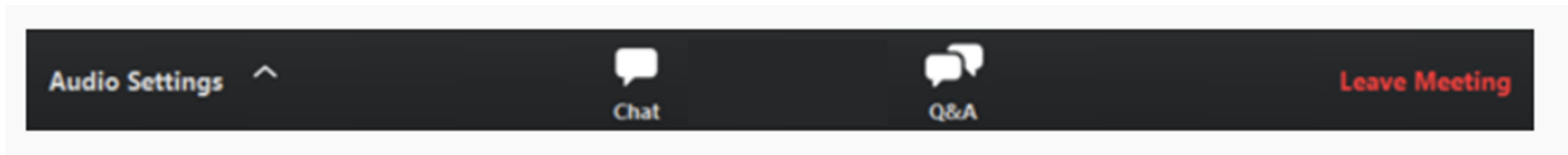

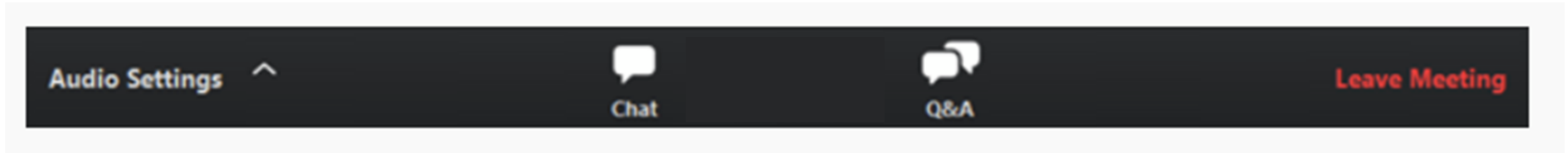

for AC 2026

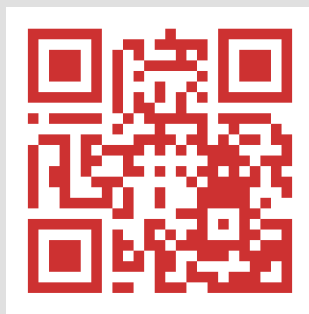
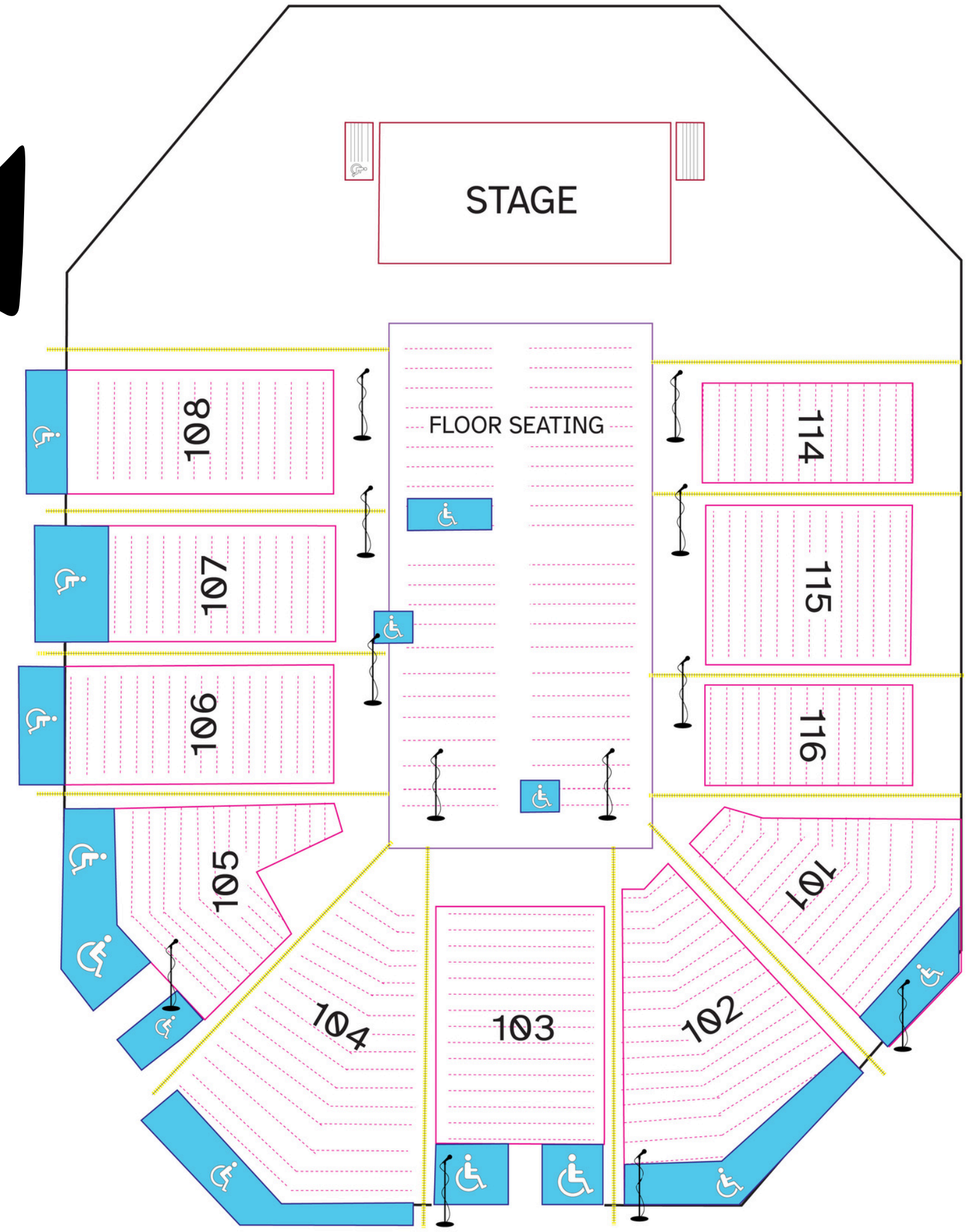
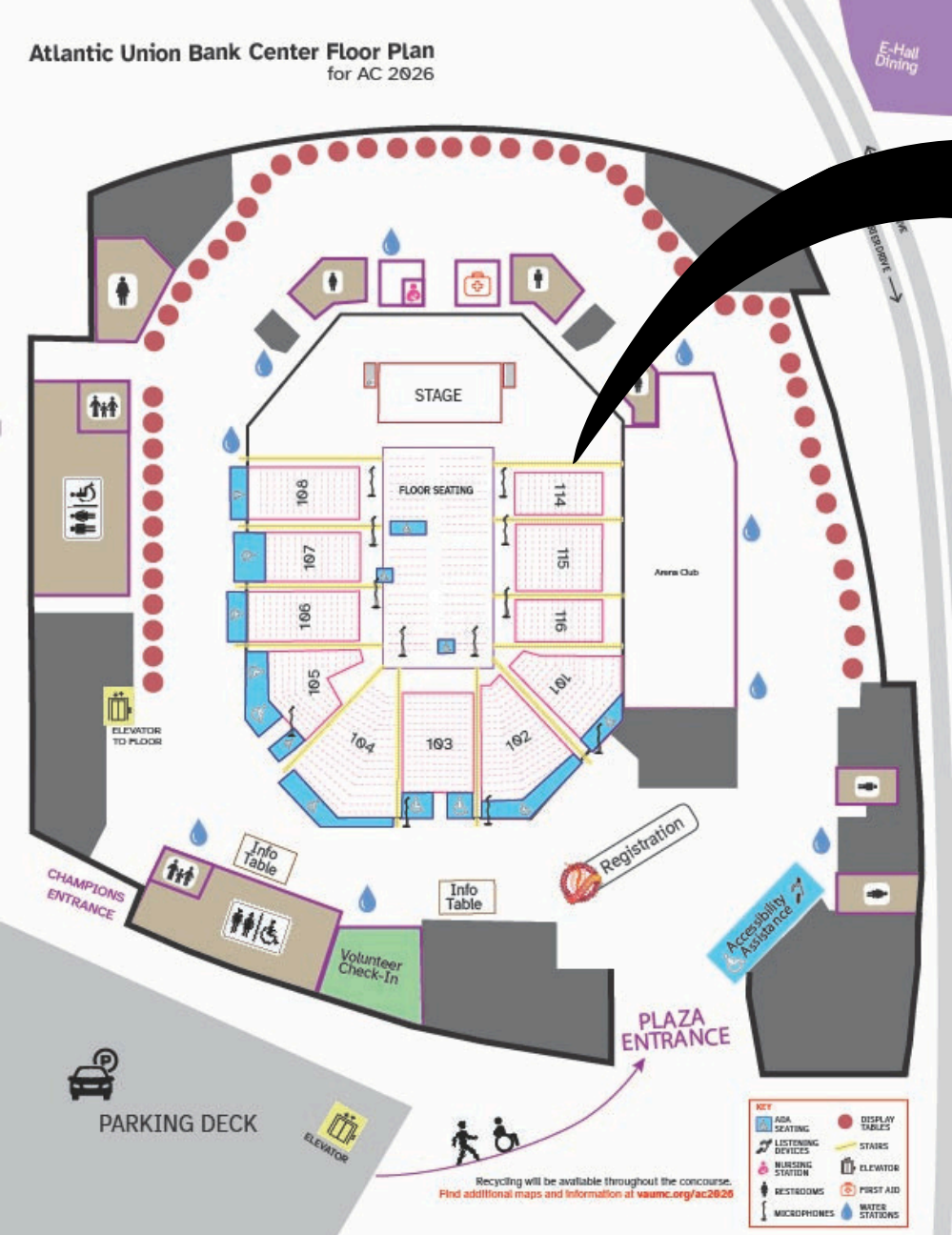
