

A typical day at camp includes breakfast, three morning activities (bible study, crafts and Harmony class where the campers learn about conflict resolution and participate in self esteem building activities), lunch, rest time, camp activities (ropes course, rock wall, zip lines, boating, archery, fishing, swimming, paddle boarding, biking, hiking, kayaking and much more!), dinner, big game evening activities, snack, devotions and bedtime.

HOW CAN i SiGN UP? Go to the website and download the camper application form. Completely fill it out and return it no later than May 15. You will receive an email confirmation once your application has been received. About 3 weeks before camp you will receive a camper packet with details about camp such as what to pack, directions and transportation information.
