

PASTOR'S WORK LOAD

A. Work Load:

Every pastor should have a *minimum* workload of 250 members or 100 family units.

If the pastor serves a circuit, there should be no more than four churches on the circuit, and preferably only two.

The workload of a pastor of a station appointment, without program staff assistants, should be a maximum of 700 members. The workload of a pastor on a circuit, without staff assistants, should be a maximum of 500 members or 200 family units.
