
- Help replenish Mission Central Depot

### Making an UMCOR Flood Bucket

5 gal. round bucket w/lid

Liquid laundry detergent (32-64 oz)

Bottle liquid household cleaner (16-40 oz)

Dish soap (16-34 oz)

Liquid pump spray air freshener (4-8 oz)

Pump spray Insect Repellent (16-14 oz) or 10-20 wipes

One scrub brush

18 re-usable wipes (no paper, microfiber or terrycloth)

5 scouring pads

36-50 clothes pins and 50-100 ft. clothesline

24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags

5 N95 respirator dust masks

Two pairs of kitchen gloves

One pair of work gloves
