## **Data Verification for 2025 Apportionments**

The expenses reported for 2023 Year-End Statistics (lines 39-47) will be used to calculate your 2025 Apportionments. Your church's Data Verification will be sent to your pastor and treasurer via email or mail on March 1<sup>st</sup>. The purpose of data verification is to review the expenses reported for the 2023 year-end statistics that are used to calculate 2025 apportionments. Any corrections are to be made directly in UnityWeb no later than March 29<sup>th</sup>. ## **Update** on General Conference

After a four-year delay, the 2020 General Conference will take place April 23-May 3, 2024 in Charlotte, NC. ## **Local Church Audit**

As churches are wrapping up 2023, the local church finance team should designate an audit committee that is independent to conduct the audit. The Audit Committee should be composed of at least two people unrelated to the treasurer, financial secretary, pastor(s), finance committee chair, business manager, those who count the offerings, or the church secretary. The key to using an audit committee made up of people within the church is *independence*, both in fact and appearance with no bias.
