*Arlington:*

Ghana Wesley UM Mission Church moves from the Arlington District to the Alexandria District, 7/1/13.

*Charlottesville:*

The Mount Pleasant Charge is realigned to include Poplar UMC. The Charge becomes a three-point station and includes Poplar, Mount Horeb, and Mount Pleasant.

*Danville:*

The Floral Hills-Mount Pleasant Cooperative Parish is discontinued. Concord-Mount Pleasant Charge (2) becomes a full-time, two-point station and Floral Hills becomes a part-time station.  
The East Danville Cooperative Parish is discontinued. Wesley Chapel-Rock Springs Charge (2) becomes a full-time station and Calvary-Kerns Memorial Charge (2) becomes two-point, part-time at 25%.  
The Patrick Charge is discontinued. Concord and Nettle Ridge become the East Patrick Charge, a full-time, two-point station and Creasey's Chapel and New Hope become the West Patrick Charge, two-point part-time at 75%.  
Granbery Church becomes 75%

*Elizabeth River:*

Bethel moves from 75% to 50%.  
Monumental: The Bridge is no longer associated with Monumental and is associated with Cottage Place, effective July 1, 2013.  
Norview moves from 100% to 75%.

*Farmville:*

The Cumberland Charge is realigned. The Charge will consist of Centenary, Hobson's Chapel, and Payne Memorial, and it will be a full-time, three-point station. Antioch will become a part-time station.  
The Rehoboth-Union Chapel Cooperative Parish is discontinued. Rehoboth and Union Chapel will each be part-time stations.  
McKendree-Asbury Charge moves from full-time to part-time.  
West Buckingham Charge moves from full-time to part-time, 75%.  
Glenwood Charge moves from 75% to 50%.  
Amelia Charge moves from 75% to 50%.

*Fredericksburg:*

Andrew Chapel-Edgewater Charge is discontinued. Andrew Chapel becomes a full-time station and Edgewater becomes a part-time station, at 25%.  
The Kilmarnock-Irvington Cooperative Parish is discontinued. Kilmarnock becomes a full-time station and Irvington becomes a part-time station at 50%.

*Harrisonburg:*

Evangelical and St- Paul (Elkton) will become a full-time, 2-point Station Charge called the Evangelical-St. Paul Charge.

*James River:*

The Dinwiddie Charge is discontinued. Lebanon becomes a full-time station and Mount Olivet becomes a part-time station at 25%.  
The South Sussex Charge is discontinued. Concord becomes a full-time station and Lebanon becomes a part-time station at 25%.  
The Greenville Charge is realigned. Independence and Mount Pleasant remain as the Greenville Charge, a full-time, two-point station. Centenary (Jarratt) becomes a part-time station at 25%.  
The Petersburg Cooperative Parish is created, consisting of St. Mark's and Washington Street.

*Lynchburg:*

Forest and Marsh Memorial become a two-point charge named the Bedford Springs Charge.  
Forest Road and Fairview become a two-point charge named Forest Road/Fairview.  
The Bethany Charge is realigned- Bethany (Concord) becomes a part-time station- Indian Hill, Early's Chapel, and Timberlake East constitute the Concord Charge, part-time.  
Emmaus and Union become a two-point charge named Emmaus/Union.
