All applicants must create an account in WebAdmit to apply. All applications for VCU and the Department of Patient Counseling are required. The Department of Patient Counseling offers two-degree programs: the Post Baccalaureate Certificate in Patient Counseling and the Master of Science degree in Patient Counseling. Applications for the winter CPE offering (January – October 2023) will be available December 1, 2022. The summer intensive offering will be from June 5 – August 4, 2023.
