Mission (Why we exist):

2. Ministry partnership with Conference clergy and lay leader.

[SEJ Goal: To identify, connect with, encourage, pray for and support clergy women.]

VAC Goal: Develop an ongoing Zoom prayer group which prays for our Bishop, Conference lay leader, and all clergy of the Virginia Conference.

3. Improve race relations

[SEJ Goal: Healing Circles – Promote the use of the Circles to foster communications and relationship building between varied constituents' groups.]

VAC Goal: Promote awareness of Healing Circles and other race related programs.

4. Engage with campus ministries and younger men.

[SEJ Goal: Engage with Wesleyan Groups, if any, in each District.]

VAC Goal: Identify campus ministries and Wesleyan Groups within each district. Develop ministry strategies to engage with younger men.

5. Embrace Scouting.

[SEJ Goal: Introduce Scouting and its values to the local Conference.]

VAC Goal: Promote the value of Scouting within each district of the Conference.

6. Advocate for environmental issues and creation care.

[SEJ Goal: United Methodist Men will be at the forefront of advocating for solutions and implementing sustainable practices in our communities.]
