Official Invitation

In order to attend Licensing School, you must receive an invitation from the District Superintendent or the Board of Ordained Ministry.

The 2022 Session of Licensing School is scheduled to take place in person at Shenandoah University: 1460 University Dr, Winchester, VA 22601.

Participation is mandatory at all events for clergy who are entering their first appointments-licensed local pastors, provisional elders, and provisional deacons. Please read on for more details.

Deadline:

Friday, May 6th, midnight. This deadline is non-negotiable in order to forecast appointments as well as needs for licensing school.

Cost/Payment

The cost to students in the Virginia Conference: \$275

The cost for students attending from other conferences: \$550

Preparation:

On-Line Course Work

Some online learning will be required prior to Licensing School. If you have completed Methodist Doctrine and Polity, as well as Methodist Mission and Evangelism courses, you will be able to upload your transcripts and receive a separate assignment.

The Center for Clergy Excellence will purchase online classes from Candler School of Theology at Emory University. Look for more information from the Associate Director for Call and Candidacy Rev. Crystal Sygeel as Licensing School approaches.

Preaching Practicum

All participants will engage in a preaching practicum during the seven days. The registration portal will allow you to **upload the sermon** you will be using for the small group presentation and debrief. There is an entire page of the registration devoted to the preaching assignment. Please read carefully.
