## **Basic Course** (10-hour course)

Hybrid Course (In Person and Virtual)

Course Description: This 2-hour orientation is designed to provide the support structure required during CLM training for those who have begun the training as well as for those who are considering the training. This cohort will continue to support one another throughout the educational process (1-4 years) while learning how CLMs are functioning in the Virginia Conference.
