Dear Fellow Workers for the Truth, consider this your invitation to join me as I seek financial and prayer support for the ministry of spreading Truth in North Macedonia. This fall I will spend forty days visiting churches and individuals in the US to share about the work I do and connect with people who would like to be a part of this work. I’m calling it *“Forty days to fully-funded!”*

The amount of money it costs to keep a missionary on the field varies by placement and other factors. Thanks to the United Methodist Church’s commitment to missions, a significant portion of these costs are covered by yearly apportionments from churches; however, the General Board of Global Missions asks all of us missionaries to raise \$25,000 a year to help cover these costs.

During my itineration, I will be visiting the following churches:

- **Sunday, November 20th** – St. Luke’s United Methodist Church in North Chesterfield, VA
- **Sunday, December 4th** – Braddock St. United Methodist Church in Winchester, VA

They are finished!

One of the most important ways churches within the Wesleyan tradition spread the Truth is by providing quality children's Sunday School classes. When I began working with the Commission for Work with Children and Youth, it became apparent that our district desperately needed Sunday school materials for children in the Macedonian language. Some teachers were using decades old materials written in Serbian and others had obtained a few lessons from Samaritan's Purse, but most were doing their best to create a lesson from scratch each week. This spring the commission partnered with Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF) to acquire the materials CEF had already translated. Our teachers underwent training and the commission set about printing, laminating, buying supplies for and organizing 22 units of lessons including Genesis, The life of Jesus, Teach us to pray, and Hudson Taylor. We are happy to announce that our teachers will now have teacher books, illustrations, worksheets and games for over two years' worth of lessons. We know this will alleviate a lot of their stress and be a blessing for them. We look forward to seeing how the children respond and the impact it makes on them as well.
